Board Report: November 17, 2020

- **Superintendent's Conference Day Training:** Teachers throughout the district worked with educational consultant Sue Stoya from CASDA (Capital Area School Development Association) to enhance curriculum. On Friday, October 23rd, teachers reviewed a skills-based approach to curriculum mapping before having an opportunity to work independently with grade-level teams.
- **ParentSquare:** DCS adopted a new communication platform for the 2020-21 school year to engage parents and share information from teachers and administrators. A survey was shared with parents to gather feedback on the first quarter of school, as well as to collect information on internet and device access.
- **Veterans Day:** In lieu of our usual celebration of veterans, DCS staff united to decorate the elementary showcase in honor of Veterans Day. Special thanks to our favorite veteran at DES, Mr. Kirchoffer, as well as Mrs. Jasewicz and Ms. Cheney for their creative efforts in designing our showcase. Several teachers honored veterans, including first graders in Mrs. Cross's classroom. Students drew pictures and wrote special messages.
- **Pumpkin Fun in First Grade:** Thanks to the donation of pumpkins from AW Greenhouse, first graders focused a week of fun and learning on pumpkins! Lessons included playdough pumpkin smashes in math, pumpkin candy catapulting, and painting!



- **Parent Conferences:** Parent-Teacher Conferences are scheduled for November 19th and 20th to discuss student progress for the 2020-21 school year. Parents were given the option of meeting in-person or via phone conference.



Academics

- Students received Quarter 1 report cards on November 13th and 16th with parent teacher conferences scheduled for November 19th and 20th. Conferences this year can be in-person, virtual, or over the phone depending on the parent's preference.
- NYSED cancelled the January Regents exams, so 7-12 students will be in session the week of January 25th.
- Parents responded to a survey on ParentSquare about challenges to hybrid learning. Results are being analyzed to create an action plan to better support families during this difficult time, including a Parent Resources section on the district website.
- Guidance counselors are starting with 8th grade students to map out a career interest plan in Naviance, eventually working with all 6-12 students.

Professional Development

- On October 23rd, 7-12 staff worked with curriculum expert Susan Stoya from CASDA to map out curriculum during hybrid learning with a focus on NYS standards and progression of skills. Ms. Stoya will work with staff on December 2nd, 9th, and 16th with follow up sessions on vertical alignment of curriculum and feedback on complete curriculum maps.
- High-Yield Instructional Strategies during in-person and virtual learning are a focus of monthly faculty meetings and classroom walkthroughs.

DCS Students and Staff in the Spotlight



- Seniors in Ms. Gracey's government and economics classes hosted a K-12 mock election to learn about how the popular vote affects the electoral college. DCS Results: Donald J. Trump- 555 votes, Joseph R. Biden- 176 votes, Other- 51 votes.
- 7-12 teachers worked with students in advisories on 11/17 on the meaning and importance of Veterans Day.
- Thanks to Katie Rockwell and Lynne Licari, our Community Schools model has firmly established the Neighborhood Center at DCS and licensed social worker Jaclyn Fredrickson is serving DCS students and their families three days a week.

- I have been assisting both principals in multiple capacities.

ATHLETIC DIRECTOR

Fall Season 1 Sports

- We successfully completed fall season 1 athletics following the regulations in place due to the COVID-19 pandemic. The student athletes competed in regional league home and away contests in girls' jv/varsity soccer, jv/varsity boys' soccer, and varsity boys'/girls' cross country.
- Our teams were competitive in a nontraditional mixed league of B, C, and D levels. While we didn't win any league titles, everyone appreciated being allowed the opportunity for these sports to occur by the Dolgeville CSD. The student athletes developed skills and memories that will last a lifetime.

Winter Sports

- Section III postponed the winter 2020-2021 Indoor Track and Field Season due to lack of facilities to host large gatherings indoors.
- Section III cancelled all Winter and Fall 2 Sectional tournament competition. **This means sports will only compete in TBD league-based competitions if allowed during the winter and fall 2 seasons.**
- Section III delayed the start of winter sports for V/JV basketball, volleyball, cheerleading, and wrestling to December 14th. These sports are considered higher risk by the NYS DOH and we are awaiting further guidance from the governor's office and NYSPHSAA for practice regulations and to allow contests before a return to play. We are asking you to appoint the coaches submitted for JV/V sports under the condition that these sports would only commence if contests are eventually allowed.
- The modified winter sport season 2 is scheduled to begin on January 4th. The CSC athletic directors will be discussing any possible changes to modified sports during a meeting I'm attending on November 18th.
