Board Report: December 15, 2020

- **Parent Conferences:** DCS families were welcomed to DCS to meet with teachers for parent conferences on Thursday, December 19th and Friday, December 20th. Parents were given opportunities to meet in-person, via Google Meet, or through phone conferences.
- **Tech Tip of the Week:** This school year, we started a new weekly strategy to share best practices in technology integration at DES. Staff share new websites, tools, Google Classroom tips, etc. with me, accompanied by “How To” directions, to share with the staff. We are all learning new ways to modify our instruction and improve virtual instruction.
- **Christmas for Children Donations at DCS:** Thanks to the coordination by Mrs. Linda Hemmerich, DCS staff donated gifts for 35 children in our school community for the Dolgeville Youth Commission’s annual gift program. Staff also donated \$191 to support the purchase of Christmas gifts for our students. Special thanks to Mrs. Jennifer Sullivan, ELA 8 teacher and Student Council Advisor, for continuing their generous contributions. Our staff’s generosity is appreciated during such difficult times in our community.
- **Curriculum Training Day:** Teachers in grades 5-8 met with our curriculum consultant from CASDA, Sue Stoya, on Wednesday, December 9th. Each department had a designated time to meet with Sue, review grade level and disciplinary skills, and critique curriculum maps. Our goal is to move forward with curriculum alignment first at the middle school level, then ultimately the district level.
- **Remote Learning Overview:** As DCS transitioned to remote learning the first two weeks in December, students in grades K-6 were provided weekly learning agendas to identify learning expectations, instructional videos or live instruction opportunities, office hours, and assignments or assessments. Please see the attached weekly agendas for each grade level. Grades 2, 5, and 6 have transitioned to increased opportunities for live instruction.
- **Progress Reports:** K-6 teachers will send student progress reports home on Monday, December 21st and Tuesday, December 22nd. Reports will include overall progress for the second quarter, as well as a specific breakdown of completion of student work on remote learning days.
- **DES Team Workshop:** K-6 staff will convene on Wednesday, December 16th for monthly team updates and professional development.

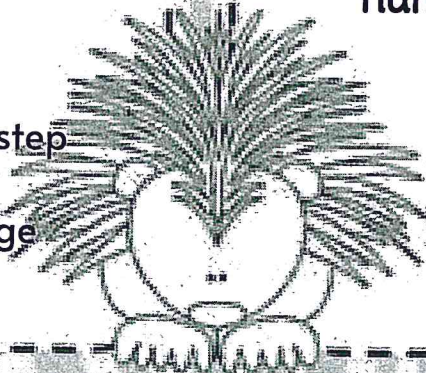

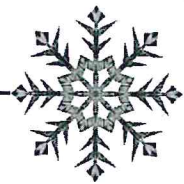

DEAN OF STUDENTS

- I have been assisting both principals in multiple capacities. I have made multiple phone calls and completed home visits to students/parents of students having difficulties with work or attending classes/lessons during our shutdown to in-person instruction after Thanksgiving break.

ATHLETIC DIRECTOR

Winter Sports

- NYSPHSAA delayed the start of winter sports for V/JV basketball, volleyball, cheerleading, and wrestling to January 4th. These sports are considered higher risk by the NYS DOH and we are awaiting further guidance from the governor's office and NYSPHSAA for practice regulations and to allow contests before a return to play. We are moving ahead with V/JV winter sport sign ups and required athletic registration (FORMRELEASE) in the hopes that a season for these sports is eventually allowed. The situation with interscholastic sports is very fluid due to the pandemic and decisions will be made as they are presented.
- We have interest again of one athlete in Varsity Nordic Alpine Skiing. We would like approval of an unpaid coach and there will be no expenses incurred by the school district to run this program.
- The CSC modified winter sport seasons were still undetermined at the time of this report. I'm asking you to appoint one coach for each winter sport at the current time with the consideration that the appointments would only commence upon an athletic season occurring with contests.

**NYSPHSAA Announces the Cancellation of All Winter State Championships;
High-Risk Sports Postponed Until Authorization is Provided**

LATHAM, NY -The New York State Public High School Athletic Association (NYSPHSAA) announces the cancellation of all 2021 Winter State Championships and the postponement of all high-risk sports until authorization is granted by state officials. The NYSPHSAA Officers rendered these decisions with input from the NYSPHSAA membership and the 11 Section Executive Directors.

“When examining the feasibility of Winter State Championships, it became apparent that travel and overnight accommodations would create a unique challenge for our member schools,” said Dr. Robert Zayas, NYSPHSAA Executive Director. “At this time, we must prioritize maximizing student participation without a focus on championship events.”

The Association’s decision to postpone all high-risk sports until authorization is granted was reinforced by the increase in infection and hospitalization rates across the State. The New York State Department of Health has determined the following NYSPHSAA-endorsed sports to be high risk: basketball, boys lacrosse, competitive cheerleading, football, ice hockey, volleyball, and wrestling.

The cancellation of the Winter State Championships (bowling, basketball, boys swimming & diving, competitive cheerleading, gymnastics, indoor track & field, ice hockey, skiing, and wrestling) addresses membership concerns associated with increased travel, hotel accommodations, transportation logistics and the planning for meals. Furthermore, venue capacity limitations and social distancing restrictions make it increasingly difficult to ensure the safety of student-athletes, coaches, and families.

“As an educator, I am witnessing first-hand the challenges our member schools are facing each day in addressing this pandemic,” said Julie Bergman, NYSPHSAA President. “It is important we continue listening to the concerns being expressed by our membership when making decisions impacting interscholastic athletics.”

Low- and moderate-risk regular season sports continue to be permitted. The 2021 NYSPHSAA Spring State Championships remain scheduled at this time.

Chem-Aqua update: The district was able to change the 20-21 Chem-Aqua contract to include a statement that they will hold us harmless from all damages to the system or conditions such as scale or corrosion arising from the negligent or intentional acts or omissions of Chem-Aqua staff as long as the negligence is not due to District employees. In addition, the contract was reduced in half of the normal rate to compensate the tube replacement 2 years ago. The new contract will run from 12/05/20-12/04/21.
