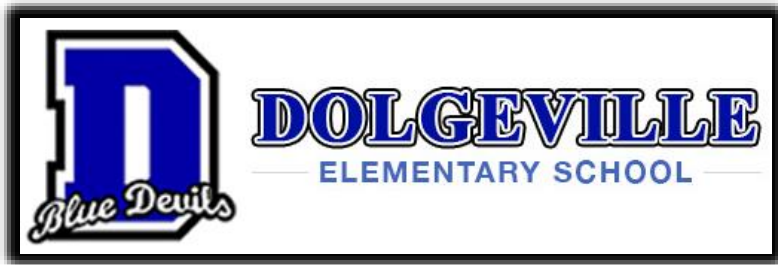

Board of Education Report: June 15, 2021

- **Policy Review - Special Education (update):** Internal audit of policy has been submitted to MORIC for review and revisions. In progress with an anticipated first reading Summer 2021.
- **Technology:** Working with Mr. Kawryga and Mrs. Radley to address restructuring of the Technology Department (including Instructional Technology needs). Recruitment process continues the week of June 13 with interviews of candidates. Met with Allison Blackwell to discuss current and future role/responsibilities at DCS.
- **Staffing:** Working with Mr. Kawryga, Mrs. Radley, and Administration to determine grant funded staffing possibilities, which are temporary positions (yearly) that will be supported by designated grant funds to address learning loss due to Covid 19. In addition, the administrative team is working to secure qualified and exceptional candidates to fill vacancies in all areas.
- **Summer Programs:** Working with Mr. Kawryga, Mrs. Radley, and Administration with summer 2021 programs at all levels, including an afternoon summer recreation program and high school summer enrichment program. Administration has been working tirelessly to organize quality summer program opportunities for our students, which are funded through grant funds.
- **Universal Pre-K:** Working directly with Mrs. Radley and Mrs. Chrisman to ensure we are utilizing funding resources to provide a Universal Pre-K program at DCS beginning Fall 2021 for eighteen resident students. We are currently in the formal application process with a goal to offer a DCS sponsored program using grant funding and in cooperation with Madison-Oneida BOCES (Coordinator - which is an Aideable expense).

- **June DES Team Meeting:** Melissa Roys, Executive Director of Connected Community Schools and Rome Alliance for Education, was a special guest and presenter for June 2nd meeting. As staff continue to navigate the struggles of supporting and serving students in our school community, Melissa provided staff training on collective trauma and COVID. Her presentation focused on the impact of collective or mass trauma on students, educators, and communities.
- **6th Grade Transition and Promotion Program:** We look forward to a day of celebrations for our current 6th graders! On Monday, June 21st, our 6th graders will be welcomed by the high school staff for their first official high school experience! With the support and collaboration of several high school staff, 6th graders are planning a tour of the high school building as well as special presentations to help acclimate our future DCS graduates. Students will conclude their day with our annual Promotion Ceremony in the auditorium at 1PM. Students are able to invite two guests to our ceremony.
- **LEGO/STEAM Program:** DES is excited to continue our after school STEAM program. This year we have 13 students that stay after school on Mondays and Wednesdays with Mr. Gardner and Mr. Seery to complete STEAM-related projects.
- **No Guts No Glory:** Mr. Simpson is leading our after-school running and character program, No Guts No Glory. This year we have approximately 15 students participating in this program, focusing on building character and sportsmanship with our 5th and 6th grade boys.
- **CSI Actions for June:** Mr. Seery and Mrs. Williams are our middle school representatives for school improvement. They have crafted a survey for all students to complete in 5th and 6th grade to gather student feedback for our upcoming school improvement plan. Survey responses will be used to guide student discussions in the shaping of our building goals.

DEAN OF STUDENTS

1. Duties involving multiple facets of assistance have been split between the two principals.

ATHLETIC DIRECTOR

1. The 2021 spring athletic season was winding down at the time of this report. Our student athletes were able to participate in softball, baseball, and track & field during a condensed season. I would like to recognize the **Varsity Boys' Track & Field** team and coaches for winning their first league title since the program was restarted in 1997.
2. The 2021 fall season for varsity sports is scheduled to begin on August 23rd and modified sports are scheduled to begin on August 30th. Student athlete sign-ups for fall sports occurred in physical education classes. I have already been actively putting together plans and schedules for the 2021 fall season. NYSPHSAA has yet to put out any information related to COVID-19 restrictions for the 2021-2022 school athletic season.
3. The CSC league of Section III promotes academic excellence within athletics by sponsoring a scholar athlete award to eligible students in grades 9-12 or those in grades 7-8 that were selectively classified. The students need to meet guidelines of grade point average, varsity letters, and school citizenship. Dolgeville CSD qualified 50 student athletes for this award in 2020-2021 that will receive a recognition jacket patch.
4. I would like to thank the Board of Education for their continued support of athletics at Dolgeville CSD. It was a crazy and difficult year as an athletic director in many different ways. The end product was giving the student-athletes an experience to play athletics during a pandemic and I feel we were able to do that with your support.
5. My last words go to Mr. Kawryga. Words can't express how thankful I am that you stepped back up to the leadership plate at DCS for this school year. Best of luck in the future and enjoy your retirement again!

Please find the attached April and May work order reports for the Building and Grounds department.

Currently our Z turn mower is waiting for a new motor and is out of commission. The Kabota Tractor was sent back to the shop this week due to a transmission leak. We are down to one mower for the season.

Dave and Wayne are working together on a solution for a repair on a section of the Building Sprinkler System, during our annual inspection; the Johnson Controls Technician reported a leak. This valve is a 700-800 lb part that we need to replace in the near future. Systems are currently running, but this part should be replaced before the next annual inspection.

The fire hydrant near the Auditorium door has been safely removed and we are currently waiting for concrete to finish out the project.
